Levin Nominated for SPS Advisor Award

Professor Jon Levin is among the nominees for the 2015 Society of Physics Students Outstanding Chapter Advisor Award.

Levin, who has been the UT SPS advisor since 2010, was listed along with seven other faculty members from across the United States as a nominee: Associate Professor Kiril Streletsky of Cleveland State University was the 2015 honoree. The award is the most prestigious of the society's honors and is awarded to one chapter advisor each year. One caveat for selection is that the advisor's chapter must have won an Outstanding Chapter Award in the two years prior. UT's SPS chapter has been recognized as an outstanding chapter three times since 2011.

Levin, who holds a bachelor's degree in economics from Stanford and a Ph.D. in physics from the University of Oregon, is the also the director of the undergraduate physics program at UT.
